

*As a result of updates to the data, these fiscal year totals for felony filings differ from those published in the Missouri Judicial Report Supplements.

- On average, almost 51,000 cases were filed with the 22nd Circuit Court each year.
 - Although filings for several case categories increased, overall filings decreased by approximately 400 each year.
- By count, the largest decreases in filings were in traffic/ordinance, circuit civil and domestic relations cases, while the largest increases were in misdemeanor/etc., associate civil/small claims and circuit felony cases.
- Associate civil/small claims cases accounted for over one-third of the court's caseload, while domestic relations accounted for one-sixth and circuit civil and misdemeanor/etc. accounted for about one-eighth each (see below).
